

HOLIDAY GARBAGE COLLECTION REMINDER

The only holidays without regular trash pick ups are Christmas day and New Years day. If Christmas or New Years falls on a weekend, the observed holiday day will be treated as the holiday. If your regular garbage day falls on one of these holidays, your trash will be picked up the following business day. Commercial garbage pick up: the City of Mills attempts to pick up some or most customers on the day before the holiday. Otherwise pick up will be the following business day. Extra trash pickup will be November 13th this month.
