**April 1, 2020**

Your personal information is confidential and is NOT shared with immigration enforcement agencies, law enforcement agencies, or to determine your eligibility for government benefits.



#### INFORMATION GATHERED IN THE CENSUS IS USED TO:

Determine how federal funds are distributed



Ensure fair representation in government



Guide the planning of community services

For the first time, you can respond to the Census online, by mail, or by phone. Watch for your invitation to respond mid-March 2020.

## **Utility Payments and Permits during COVID-19 Closure**

Utility bills can be paid by either calling us to make a payment over the phone, dropping your payment in the black drop box at the drive/entrance into the Town Hall parking lot, mailing it to PO Box 789, or logging on to [xpressbillpay.com](http://xpressbillpay.com).

Permits can be downloaded/printed from our website. Complete the permit and return it either by dropping it in the drop box, mailing it to PO Box 789, faxing it to 307-234-6528, or emailing it to [info@millswy.gov](mailto:info@millswy.gov). You can send a check for payment or call in and pay over the phone for the cost of the permit. If you are unsure of the fee please call us.
