

This Holiday Season please remember to pour your grease, fat, & used cooking oil into a sealable container and throw it away. It is NEVER acceptable to pour these contaminants down the drain. 1 out of 5 sewer main back ups are caused by fats, oils, and

grease! Sewer back ups affect everyone, and ultimately cleanup and damages are the responsibility of the homeowner . Lets all work together to keep our sewers clean and free from damaging oils and fats.



### GARBAGE COLLECTION REMINDERS

The only Holidays without regular trash pick ups are Thanksgiving day, Christmas day and New Years day. If Christmas or New Years falls on a weekend, the observed Holiday day will be treated as the Holiday. If your regular garbage day falls on one of these Holidays, your trash will be picked up the following business day.

Commercial garbage pick up: the Town of Mills attempts to pick up some or most customers on the day before the Holiday. Otherwise pick up will be the following business day.
