CCR Report: Our source water assessment is available on the City of Mills website (millswy.gov), City Hall, and at the Water Treatment Plant.

City staff are working closely with the Casper Area MPO on a study to construct a non-motorized use biking/hiking trail through the Mills community. The study will seek public comment again in August. Keep an eye

out for the public comment period as we need your input to make this trail a true community enhancement.
