Who's ready for a bike trail through Mills?

City staff are working closely with the Casper Area MPO on a study to construct a non-motorized use biking/hiking trail through the Mills community. The trail would connect to the current Platte River Trails system to provide several miles of trail connectivity. The study will seek public comment again in July or August. Keep an eye out for the public comment period as we need your input to make this trail a true community enhancement.
