The Town of Mills and Casper Area MPO have partnered with ECS Engineers for a Planning and Environmental Linkage (PEL) Study of the Chamberlin Road corridor/connection between the Town and the Dempsey Acres area south of Mills. Chamberlin Road is currently the only access for the Dempsey Acres area. The PEL Study will address ways that the Town and MPO can ensure continued access in and out of Dempsey Acres.

The only Holiday without regular trash pickup is New Years day. With New Years a Friday this year, the observed Holiday day will be treated as the Holiday. If your regular garbage day falls on Friday Jan 1, your trash will be picked up on Saturday, Jan 2. There will be extra pickup on Dec 31.

Commercial garbage pick up: the Town of Mills attempts to pick up some or most customers on the day before the Holiday. Otherwise pick up will be the following day.
