From the Chief:

Recreational vehicle (RV) fire safety

Most RV fires occur between the hours of 2 and 3 p.m., during the months of May through August, and on Fridays and Saturdays. The Mills Fire Department would like to offer the following Life-saving tips for the RV user:

- Check propane supply lines for kinks or damage. Test all fitting connections with a gas leak detection device.
- Make sure generator exhaust is pointed away and downwind of the RV.
- Stay in the cooking area when preparing food. If you leave, turn off the burner.
- Have a portable fire extinguisher on board that you can easily reach. Adults should take a brief training course on how to properly use an extinguisher. Remember the acronym P.A.S.S. — Pull, Aim, Squeeze, Sweep.
- Keep doors and windows clear for escape and make sure they open easily.

Practice a fire escape plan with everyone staying in the RV.

- Don't overload the electrical outlets. Using too many electrical appliances at the same time can cause a fire.
- Have a trained technician thoroughly inspect your RV at least once a year.

Casper-Natrona County Health Department Mills Health Clinic

Casper-Natrona County Health Department is now offering Healthy U, a free, six-week workshop for adults with chronic health conditions and their friends, family, and caregivers. You'll learn powerful strategies to help you take control of your health and get relief from symptoms like pain, fatigue, anxiety, and depression. Subjects include action planning, dealing with frustration about how to communicate with health professionals, evaluating new treatments, healthy eating, decision making, and appropriate exercise. The workshop will take place at 475 S. Spruce St. every Wednesday from 5:30 – 8pm, starting on August 3rd. We will be holding an informational session on July 20th at 5:30pm at the Casper-Natrona County Health Dept. Space is limited.
