HOLIDAY GARBAGE COLLECTION REMINDERS

The only Holidays without regular trash pick ups are Christmas day and New Years day. If Christmas or New Years falls on a weekend, the observed Holiday day will be treated as the Holiday. If your regular garbage day falls on one of these Holidays, your trash will be picked up the following business day. Commercial garbage pick up: the City of Mills attempts to pick up some or most customers on the day before the Holiday. Otherwise pick up will be the following business day.



Remember, the City of Mills offers a free extra trash pick-up, every other Thursday. So for all of those extra holiday gift boxes and wrapping paper, make sure you get put on the list so we can haul them away for you.

The Mills City Offices will be closed on January 1st for the New Year Holiday!

Friendly Reminder

Per ordinance 8.20.190 Removal of snow and ice, it is the owners and/or occupants responsibility to remove snow, ice or slush from sidewalks abutting said property and maintain them free of the same. If any owner or occupant fail to comply with this subsection, the city may, after a reasonable effort to contact the owner/and or occupant either in person or by telephone, have the snow, ice or slush removed and charge the owner or occupant for the costs thereof, as provided in section 8.20.070.

It is unlawful for any person to remove snow from private property and place the same on the public street in such quantity, or in such a manner, as to cause a hazard to travel, without adequate arrangements for the immediate removal thereof.

So with this said, please keep sidewalks clear of snow and ice and do not put your snow and ice out into the street.
