During cold weather months, don't forget to let your faucet drip slowly to help prevent pipes from freezing. The dripping faucet should be as far away from the initial water source as possible so the water will flow through the entire length of the system. A constant dripping faucet will relieve pressure that is building up in the pipe between an ice blockage and the faucet, and helps to prevent the pipes from bursting when the pipes begin to thaw.
