## LOTS OF CHANGES ARE HAPPENING! PLEASE READ ABOUT ALL THE CHANGES IN THIS NEWSLETTER!

Due to the large amount of non-payments and payment arrangements, the City Council has decided that the City office will no longer be making payment arrangement for water, sewer and garbage bills. If you are the person on the utility bill, it is your responsibility to make sure all payments are made by the last day of the month, each month. This also goes for any LIEAP/WAP and LIWHAP applicants. All account holders are responsible for their timely payments, when the City receives a payment from these programs we will apply it to your account. If you have a certain circumstance that is keeping you from paying on time, you may come to a City Council meeting and discuss this with the Mayor and Council. PAYMENT





Beginning July 1st, 2023 the City of Mills will begin charging a fire inspection fee, based on the square footage of the building. The fire inspection fee will replace the business license fee of \$65.00. Per city ordinance, a business license is required to operate a business in the City of Mills and an annual fire inspection is required to obtain a business license.
