WINTER WEATHER REMINDERS

Heater and Fire Safety



HEATER/FIRE

- NO UNATTENDED HEATERS
- MIN. 3-5FT FROM OBJECTS
- FUNCTIONING DETECTORS
- DON'T USE POWER STRIPS

*Be cautious when using a space heater and do not leave the heater unattended. A heater should be placed a **MINIMUM OF 3-5 FEET** from combustible objects and flammable materials, such as blankets. When using space heaters, refrain from using Power Strips and extension cords. Plug space heater directly into a current protected wall outlet.*

*Ensure your smoke detectors and carbon monoxide **DETECTORS ARE FUNCTIONING PROPERLY.***
