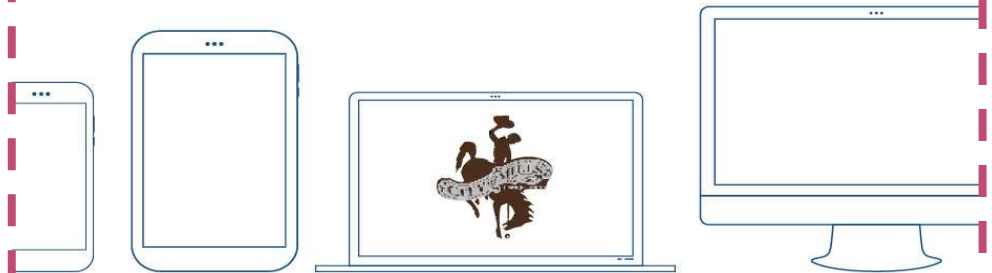


The City offices will be closed November 11th in observation of Veterans Day.

HOLIDAY GARBAGE COLLECTION REMINDERS

The only Holidays without regular trash pick ups are Christmas day and New Years day. If Christmas or New Years falls on a weekend, the observed Holiday day will be treated as the Holiday. If your regular garbage day falls on one of these Holidays, your trash will be picked up the following business day. Commercial garbage pick up: the Town of Mills attempts to pick up some or most customers on the day before the Holiday. Otherwise pick up will be the following business day.
