### **Responsibility of Mills Property Owners**

Title 8, Chapter 8.15\_of the Mills Municipal Codes states that it is the responsibility of every owner of any lot or parcel of ground in the City to keep the lot and the parcel of ground, parkways, alleyways and the sidewalk areas abutting thereon, free from weeds, grass or other lawful vegetable growth which is in excess of eight (8) inches in height and that is detrimental to the neighborhood. It is the responsibility of the owner of the lot or parcel to control the vegetation as prescribed above for the duration of the calendar year.

Chapter 8.20 of the Mills Municipal Codes states that the property maintenance and nuisance abatement requirements are designed to ensure public health, safety and welfare by regulating and governing the conditions and maintenance of property and improvements within the city; by providing standards essential to ensure that structures and properties are safe, sanitary and fit for occupation and use; to improve the appearance the city; encourage a more attractive environment; improve quality of life, and increase the value of properties with in the city.
