As of July 1st, 2023 the City of Mills has begun charging a fire inspection fee, based on the square footage of the building. The fire inspection fee will replace the business license fee of \$65.00. Per city ordinance, a business license is required to operate a business in the City of Mills and an annual fire inspection is required to obtain a business license.

State and federal licensing is not recognized by the City. These fire inspections are to insure the safety of our community is at the utmost importance.

Did you know...We now have a school back in the Mills community! The Mills Elementary School was closed in 2016 and the Mountain View Elementary School was closed in 2018 which was the last school in Mills.
