





## Friendly Reminder: Snow & Ice Removal

As a reminder, City Ordinance 8.20.190 requires all property owners and occupants to keep sidewalks adjacent to their property clear of snow, ice, and slush. If sidewalks are not maintained, and we are unable to reach the owner or occupant after reasonable attempts, the City may remove the snow or ice and bill the property owner as outlined in Ordinance 8.20.070.

Please also note that it is unlawful to push or pile snow from private property onto public streets in a way that creates a hazard, unless arrangements are made for its immediate removal.

With that in mind, we kindly ask everyone to keep sidewalks safely cleared and avoid placing snow or ice onto the roadway.

Your cooperation helps keep our community safe for pedestrians and drivers alike.
