## ORDINANCE NUMBER ELEVEN.

DOGS - LICENSE.

HE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Mills, State of Wyoming:

Dogs.

Sec.1. Every owner or possessor, and every person who harbors or keeps any dog or dogs within the corporate limits of the Town of Mills, shall annually pay to the Town Clerk of the Town of Mills for the use and benefit of the Town, the sum of five dollars for each and every male dog and the sum of ten dollars for each and every female dog owned, possessed, harbored, or kept by such person.

Chickens, etc., not run at large-Penalty.

Sec. 2. Any person who shall, in this town, keep do wes, chickens, turkeys or other domeetic fowls, shall keep the same upon his own premises and shall not permit the same to go upon the premises of others and injure or damage any keep lawn, plants, garden, flowers, fruit or other property thereon or commit any nuisance thereon. Any person violating the provisions of this section, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in a sum not exceeding ten dollars.

Cattle, etc.

Sec.3. That whoever shall permit any live stock, cattle, horses, mules, donkeys or other domestic animals to run at large within the boundary of said town, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum of not less than two nor more than twenty-five dollars for each and every offense.

Sec. 5. The Town Marshal shall have the right to impound any such domestic animal and to retain the same until all costs and expenses therefor shall be paid by the owner or claimant thereof.
