

ORDINANCE NO. 114

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO MINORS OBTAINING INTOXICATING LIQUOR AND PENALTY FOR VIOLATION. ALSO THEFT AND PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1. SOLICITATION OR PURCHASE BY MINORS UNLAWFUL. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of Twenty-One (21) years to purchase, sell, possess, or solicit the purchase or sale of intoxicating or malt liquors in the Town of Mills, or for any person to sell, give or deliver intoxicating or malt liquors to any person under the age of Twenty-One (21) years. Any violation of this Section shall upon conviction be punishable by a fine not exceeding One-Hundred dollars. (\$100.00)

SECTION 2. FELONIOUSLY TAKING AWAY OF PERSONAL GOODS OF ANOTHER. Whoever shall feloniously steal, take and carry, lead or drive away the personal goods of another, on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One-Hundred dollars (\$100.00).

SECTION 3. SHOULD ANY SENTENCE, CLAUSE, PARAGRAPH, SECTION OR PROVISION OF THIS ordinance be decided by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the particular sentence, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance so held to be invalid.
