ORDINANCE NUMBER FOURTEEN.

TAXIS, HACKS AND DRAYS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Mills, State of Wyoming:
Taxis, hacks and drays.

Sec.1. Any person or persons or corporations, who shall hire out, keep for use for hire, or cause to be let for hire on the streets, thorough-fares or alleys of the Town of Mills, any vehicle, automobile, truck or motor car of any description or name whatsoe wer, either for the conveyance of passengers or for the conveyance or transportation of goods, wares and merchandise or other material from place to clace within this town without a license so to do, which said license shall be issued by the Town Clerk upon the payment of required sum as a license and tax provided herein, provided however, that where in any ordinance special provisions for the issuance of any licensee is made, those provisions shall control and any person operating such vehicle, hack, dray, truck or motor car without first obtaining a license therefor, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum of not less than five nor more than twenty-five dollars for each and every offense. License fee.

Sec. 2. Except as otherwise provided by the ordinance of this town, there shall be paid for each vehicle mentioned in the preceding section, a license fee of fifteen dollars per annum and no license shall be issued for less than one year.
