

ORDINANCE NO. 146

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE INCLUSION OF BLOCK 9 OF KISKIS SUB-DIVISION WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING AND PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS The Town Council of the Town of Mills have determined the above described property meets the following described requirements, to-wit:

A. That the annexation of said area is for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the persons residing in the area and in the Town of Mills.

B. That the urban development of the area sought to be annexed will constitute a natural, geographical, economic and social part of the Town of Mills.

C. That the area sought to be annexed is a logical and feasible addition to the Town of Mills and the extension of the basic town services such as water and sewer system, police and fire protection, and other services as are customarily available to the residents of the town, can be reasonably furnished to the area proposed to be annexed.

D. That the area sought to be annexed is contiguous with the Town of Mills, and

WHEREAS all of the owners owning all of the above described property have petitioned the Mayor and the Council of the Town of Mills to have said tract of land included within the corporate limits of the Town of Mills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Mills that the petition for the annexation for Block 9 of Kiskis Subdivision, more fully described as:

A tract of land in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, Township 33 North Range 80 West of the 6th P.M., containing 0.56 acres more or less, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Section 12, Township 33 North, Range 80 West of the 6th P.M.; thence South 88° 52' West 343.1 feet along the north line of said Section 12 to a point, said point being the intersection of the north boundary of Section 12 and the north boundary of U. S. Wyo. Highway No. 20; thence south 66° 47' East 374.9 feet along the north boundary of U. S. Highway No. 20 to a point, said point being the intersection of the east boundary of Section 12 and the north boundary of U. S. Wyo. Highway No. 20; thence North 0° 34' West 156.2 feet along the east boundary of said Section 12 to the point of beginning, said above described tract of land containing 0.56 acres, more or less, in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 33 North, Range 80 West, of the 6th P.M., Natrona County, Wyoming.

be and the same is hereby granted and allowed and said tract be, and hereby is included and made a part of the Town of Mills.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor and Town Clerk of the Town of Mills be, and they hereby are, directed and ordered and empowered to cause to be prepared and to be filed in the office of the Registrar of Deeds in and for the County of Natrona, a plat showing the boundaries of said tract so added to said Town of Mills.

WHEREAS an emergency exists and such is declared to be the case, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the town Council and proclaimed by the Mayor of the Town of Mills, Wyoming.
