

ORDINANCE NO. 151

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE STORAGE OF MORE THAN FIVE GALLONS OF KEROSENE, COAL OIL, GASOLINE, BENZINE, NAPHTHA, OR HIGHLY INFLAMMABLE FLUID AND PROVIDING FOR A CONTAINER THEREFORE, AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR UNDERGROUND TANKS FOR SAID PETROLEUM PRODUCTS IN EXCESS OF FIVE GALLONS AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING.

Section 1. No person shall keep in any one building, within the town of Mills, Wyoming, at any one time, more than five gallons of kerosene, coal oil, gasoline, benzine, naphtha or other highly inflammable fluid or substance. All of said petroleum products, when stored will be in red colored metal canisters, plainly marked as to the contents thereof. Any person desiring to store, within the town limits of the Town of Mills, Wyoming, any of said petroleum products in quantities of more than five gallons must store said products in tanks buried below the ground.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in an amount not exceeding \$100.00.
