

ORDINANCE NO. 159

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT SECTION 18, C OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 130, WHICH IS AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON STREETS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1. That Section 18, C, be amended and re-enacted as follows;

(C) In zones where special hazards exist, the town marshal shall have authority to place "danger" and "go slow" signs to clearly mark said zones.

(1) Fifteen miles per hour:

(a) Basic speed limit in all alleys.

(2) Twenty miles per hour:

(a) Basic speed limit on all streets other than designated through streets.

(3) Thirty miles per hour:

(a) Basic speed limit on through streets except Fourth Street, on which the speed limit shall be twenty miles per hour.
