

ORDINANCE NUMBER SIXTEEN.

RESISTING AN OFFICER.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Mills, State of Wyoming:

Resisting officer--Penalty.

Sec. 1. Whoever in the city shall resist any police officer, or any member of the police department, or any person duly empowered with police authority while in the discharge of his duty, or shall in any way interfere with or hinder him in the discharge of his duty, or shall offer, or endeavor to do so; and whoever shall in any manner assist any person in the custody of a police officer, or member of the police department, or other person empowered with police authority, or attempt to escape from such custody, or shall rescue or attempt to rescue, any person or persons in custody, shall be fined not less than five nor more than one hundred dollars.
