

ORDINANCE NO. 165

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR, COUNCILMEN, CLERK-TREASURER, MARSHAL AND POLICE JUDGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY, WYOMING:

Section 1. COMPENSATION OF MAYOR.

The Mayor of the Town of Mills shall be paid the sum of \$8.00 for each council meeting attended by him.

Section 2. COMPENSATION OF COUNCILMEN.

Councilmen of the Town of Mills shall be paid the sum of \$4.00 each for each council meeting attended.

Section 3. COMPENSATION OF CLERK-TREASURER.

The Clerk=Treasurer of the Town of Mills shall be paid the sum of \$325.00 each month during the term of her employment.

Section 4. COMPENSATION OF THE MARSHAL.

The Marshal of the Town of Mills shall be paid the sum of \$475.00 each month during the term of his employment.

Section 5. COMPENSATION OF THE POLICE JUDGE.

The Police Judge of the Town of Mills shall be paid the sum of \$60.00 each month during the term of his employment.
