ORDINANCE NO. 172

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING OF VEHICLES IN ALLEYS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY, WYOMING, EXCEPT UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA, COUNTY, WYOMING:

No person shall park a vehicle within an alley in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than ten feet of the width of the roadway for the free movement of vehicular traffic, and no person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle within an alley in such a position as to block the driveway entrance to any abutting property, nor shall any person leave a vehicle parked unattended in an alley, excepting for the purpose of actual loading or unloading in any alley. Vehicles may be permitted to park in any alley in residential areas provided not less than ten feet of the roadway is left for free movement of traffic.
