

ORDINANCE NO. 175

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING SECTION
8 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 48 OF THE TOWN OF MILLS,
WYOMING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS,
NATRONA COUNTY, WYOMING.

SECTION 1. THAT SECTION 8 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 48, BE AMENDED
AND RE-ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 8. All persons licensed under this chapter shall
close the dispensing room and cease the sale of both alcoholic and malt
liquors promptly at the hour of two o'clock a.m. each day and keep the
same closed until six o'clock a.m. the same day except that such places
may open the dispensing room Sunday between the hours of one o'clock p.m.
and eight o'clock p.m.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from
and after passage on three readings and publication.

Passed on 1st reading, the 19 day of May, 1967.

Passed on 2nd reading, the 9 day of June, 1967.
