

ORDINANCE NUMBER TWENTY.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING CERTAIN RIGHTS TO
R.E.WERTS, AGENT, HIS SUCCESSORS AND
ASSIGNS IN THE TOWN OF MILLS, STATE OF WYOMING.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Mills,
State of Wyoming:

Sec.1. There is hereby granted to R.E.Werts, his successors
and assigns, the right to lay, bury, construct, repair, remove and
operate a gas line over that certain street known as Northwestern
Avenue, in the Town of Mills, State of Wyoming.

Sec.2. That such line shall be at least twelve feet from
the property line along said street and shall be buried at a depth of
at least three feet and shall be so buried as not to interfere with
water or sewer line, which may be hereafter be laid or buried along
said street.

Sec.3. That said line shall be laid and maintained in a
good and workmanlike manner and when the same shall be laid, the
excavation shall be filled and levelled and during the construction
of said line along said street, proper warning signals shall be
maintained until thoroughly settled.

Sec.4. The laying of such line shall be done in such a
manner that the traffic of First Street shall not be blocked and
all manholes or other fixtures or appliances shall be so maintained
and constructed as not to extend above the grade of such street.

Sec.5. The level of Northwestern Avenue shall at all times
be maintained over this line.
