

ORDINANCE NUMBER TWENTY-THREE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Mills, that whereas it is necessary to provide for the general expenses of said town, and whereas it is now determined that in order to meet the necessary expenses of said town of Mills, that a tax of eight (8) mills shall be levied upon the assessed valuation of said town for the municipal purposes of the fiscal year, beginning with May 1, 1922, and ending with May 1, 1923.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Town Clerk shall be instructed and is hereby authorized to certify to the County Clerk of Natrona County under section 2931 and Section 2932, of the Wyoming Compiled Statutes of 1920, that it will be necessary to make an assessment of eight (8) mills on each dollar of the assessed valuation of all property, real, personal and mixed, within the said town of Mills, Wyoming.

And be it further resolved that the said Clerk shall proceed to make the assessments and furnish the certificate necessary under the preceding sections of the Statutes.

Passed this _____ day of March, 1922, to be published by posting for a period of ten (10) days from the above date in three (3) conspicuous places in the said Town of Mills, Wyoming.
