

ORDINANCE NUMBER TWENTY-FIVE.

AN ORDINANCE for the submitting to the vote of the qualified electors of the Town of Mills, a municipal corporation in the County of Natrona and State of Wyoming, at the general election of said Town to be held on the second Tuesday in May, 1922, the question of authorizing the Town Council of said Town of Mills to contract an indebtedness for and on behalf of said Town for the purpose of providing funds for the establishment and construction of a water works system for said town, consisting of wells, pumps, towers, tanks, storage appliances and bridges and other appurtenances necessary or incident to the establishment and operation of a complete water system, for the purpose of supplying inhabitants of said Town with water for domestic, manufacturing and other purposes, by issuing the coupon bonds of said Town.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Mills:

Sec.1. That a general election of the qualified electors of the Town of Mills in the County of Natroaa and State of Wyoming be called and held and is hereby called for Tuesday, May 9, 1922.

Sec.2. That at said election there shall be and there is hereby submitted to the qualified electors of said Town of Mills, the following question and proposition, to-wit:

Shall the Town of Mills in the County of Natrona and State of Wyoming, through its Town Council and proper officers, be authorized to borrow the sum of Seventy thousand dollars, and to issue 140 coupon bonds of said Town of Mills, each of said bonds to be of the denomination of Five Hundred Dollars(\$500.00) which said bonds shall be numbered consecutively from one upwards, payable in thirty years from the date of issue, redeemable at the pleasure of said town after fifteen years, and to bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, and on such dates of each year as the Town Council shall determine, principal and interest payable in lawful money of the United States at such place or places as shall be designated by the Town Council, said bonds to be executed, sold and delivered as provided by law for the purpose of providing funds for constructing a system of water works to supply said Town of Mills with water for the extinguishment of fires and for supplying the inhabitants thereof with water for domestic, manufacturing and other purposes.

Sec.3. The question and proposition so submitted shall be voted on at said election by the voters qualified by law at the usual place of voting in said town of Mills. The voting shall be by ballot of the form hereinafter provided, and said election shall be in all respects as nearly as may be, held and conducted and the vote canvassed and returned and the result declared in the manner prescribed by law in case of elections

for municipal officers. On the day and date of said election the poll and ballot box shall be opened as soon after 7:00 o'clock in the morning as possible and shall be kept open without any adjournment until 4:00 o'clock in the afternoon, at which time such poll and such ballot box shall be closed.

Registration for such election shall take place as provided by law.

Sec.4. At such election the official ballot shall contain and set forth among other things, the following proposition and shall contain the words as follows:

PROPOSITION SUBMITTED:

Shall the town of Mills in the County of Natrona and State of Wyoming, through its town council and proper officers, be authorized to borrow the sum of Seventy thousand dollars and to issue 140 coupon bonds of said town of Mills, each of said bonds to be of the denomination of five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) which said bonds shall be numbered consecutively from one upwards, payable in thirty years from the date of issue, redeemable at the pleasure of said town after fifteen years, and to bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, and on such dates of each year as the town council shall determine, principal and interest payable in lawful money of the United States at such place or places as shall be designated by the town council, said bonds to be executed, sold and delivered as provided by law for the purpose of providing funds for constructing a system of water works to supply said town of Mills with water for the extinguishment of fires and for supplying the inhabitants thereof with water for domestic, manufacturing and other purposes.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE VOTER:

The elector shall prepare his ballot by crossing therefrom such parts so that the remaining parts shall express his vote upon the proposed question submitted.

Sec.5. The mayor and town clerk are hereby directed and authorized to make a proclamation not less than ten days before said general municipal election hereby provided for, which shall be posted in three public places in said town, setting forth the fact that on the 9th day of May, 1922, a general municipal election will take place for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the town among other
