AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CENTER WEST SUBDIVISION TO THE TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY, WYOMING.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mills is desirous of annexing the lands hereinafter described and including said lands within the corporate limits of the Town of Mills; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town Council of the Town of Mills that an annexation of the area hereinafter described is for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the persons residing in the area and in the Town of Mills; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the development of the area sought to be annexed would constitute a natural, geographical, economical and social part of the Town of Mills; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town Council that the area sought to be annexed is a logical and feasible addition to the Town of Mills and that the extension of basic services such as water and sewer systems, police and fire protection and other services customarily available to residents of the Town of Mills can reasonably be furnished to the area proposed to be annexed; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town Council that the area sought to be annexed is contiguous with and adjacent to the boundaries of the Town of Mills; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the petitioner for annexation is the owner of all the land sought to be annexed, and that, therefore, no public hearing is required prior to annexing said land;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Mills, Wyoming:

SECTION 1. That a certain tract of land being all of

Center West Subdivision to the Town of Mills, being a subdivision of part of the S½SE¼ of Section 6 and the NE¼NE¼ of Section 7 all in Township 33 North, Range 79 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Natrona County, Wyoming, described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and, by this reference, made a part hereof, be, and the same is, annexed to and included within the boundaries of the Town of Mills, Natrona County, Wyoming.

SECTION 2. That the area herein annexed and hereinbefore described shall be known as Center West Subdivision to the Town of Mills, Natrona County, Wyoming.

SECTION 3. That a plat showing the boundaries of said annexed tract has been submitted to and is approved by the Town Council of the Town of Mills and the mayor and town clerk are authorized to sign, attest and affix the seal of the town on said plat, and said plat shall be filed for record in the office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds of Natrona County, Wyoming.

SECTION 4. That the annexation of said tract of land to the Town of Mills shall become effective upon the passage of this ordinance.

Beginning at the northwest corner of said SISEL of Section 6; thence N 88054'14"E, along the north boundary of said S'2SE'4, a distance of 1139.12 feet to a point on the westerly boundary of the presently existing Salt Creek Highway; thence S 8032'45"E, along said westerly boundary, a distance of 633.83 feet; thence S 81<sup>o</sup>29'38"W, a distance of 10.00 feet; thence S  $8^{\circ}30'22''E$ , a distance of 89.22 feet to the point of beginning of a circular curve to the right, the radius of which is 666.20 feet and the total central angle of which is  $45^{\circ}56'38''$ ; thence along said curve, through a central angle of 45°56'38", a distance of 534.21 feet; thence S 37<sup>o</sup>26'16"W, a distance of 145.34 feet, more or less, to a point on the south boundary of said Section 6; thence S 89°17'18"W, along said south boundary, a distance of 965.48 feet to a point on the easterly boundary of the Burlington Northern Railroad operating right of way. thence N 39059'30"W, along last said boundary, a distance of 76.53 feet to a point on the west boundary of said  $S^1_SE^1_a$ ; thence N  $0^009^139^{\prime\prime}W$ , along last said boundary, a distance of 1267.00 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
