ORDINANCE NO. 289

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING WATER TANK ADDITION NO. 2 TO THE TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY WYOMING

WHEREAS, the Town of Mills is desirous of annexing the lands hereinafter described and including said lands within the corporate limits of the Town of Mills; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town Council of the Town of Mills that an annexation of the area hereinafter described is for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the persons residing in the area and in the Town of Mills; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the development of the area sought to be annexed would constitute a natural, geographical, economical and social part of the Town of Mills; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town Council that the area sought to be annexed is a logical and feasible addition to the Town of Mills and that the extension of basic services such as water and sewer systems, police and fire protection and other services customarily available to residents of the Town of Mills can reasonably be furnished to the area proposed to be annexed; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town Council that the area sought to be annexed is contiguous with and adjacent to the boundaries of the Town of Mills; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Town of Mills is the owner of all the land sought to be annexed, and that, therefore, no public hearing is required prior to annexing said land;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Mills, Wyoming:

SECTION 1. That a certain tract of land being all of Water Tank Addition No. 2 to the Town of Mills, being a sub-division of part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW 4 NW 4 § 12 all in Township 33 North, Range 80 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Natrona County, Wyoming,

Hand, Hand & Hand, P.C. Attorneys Casper, Douglas, and Glenrock, Wyoming described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and, by this reference, made a part hereof, be, and the same is, annexed to and included withing the boundaries of the Town of Mills, Natrona County, Wyoming.

SECTION 2. That the area herein annexed and hereinbefore described shall be known as Water Tank Addition No. 2 to the Town of Mills, Natrona County, Wyoming.

SECTION 3. That a plat showing the boundaries of said annexed tract has been submitted to and is approved by the Town Council of the Town of Mills and the mayor and town clerk are authorized to sign, attest and affix the seal of the town on said plat, and said plat shall be filed for record in the office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds of Natrona County, Wyoming.

SECTION 4. That the annexation of said tract of land to the Town of Mills shall become effective upon the passage of this ordinance.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF WATER TANK ADDITION NO. 2
