

ORDINANCE NUMBER TWENTY-NINE.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING CERTAIN RIGHTS TO PRODUCERS
AND REFINERS CORPORATION, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS,
IN THE TOWN OF MILLS, STATE OF WYOMING.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Mills;

Sec.1. There is hereby granted to Producers and Refiners Corporation, its successors and assigns, a right to lay, bury, construct, and repair, remove and operate a water line, four to eight inches and a three inch gasoline line over that certain street known as Northwestern Avenue in the Town of Mills.

Sec.2. That such lines shall be laid in a convenient manner along the gas line as granted to R.E.Wertz, agent, his successors and assigns by an ordinance heretofore passed, and shall be buried at a depth of at least three feet, and be so buried as not to interfere with any other lines heretofore laid in said street, and said lines shall not interfere with the proposed water line now in the process of construction and being laid for the use of the inhabitants of said town, and said lines shall be laid in some convenient place between the center of the street and the northeast side line of said street.

Sec.3. That said lines shall be laid and maintained in a good and workmanlike manner and when the same shall be laid the excavations shall be filled and leveled, and during the construction of said lines along said street proper warning signals shall be maintained until thoroughly settled.

Sec.4. That the level of Northwestern Avenue shall at all times be maintained.

Sec.5. That Producers and Refiners Corporation shall furnish a map or maps showing the location and position of said water line and gasoline line, which said map or maps shall be filed with the Town Clerk.

Sec.6. That in the opinion of the Council an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance is hereby passed and approved upon the aye and nay vote of said Council on this 27th day of November, 1922.
