ORDINANCE NO. 29/

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE POSSESSION OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND DRUNKENESS IN PARK OR CEMETERY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Town of Mills, Wyoming:

SECTION 1. That the offense of possessing or consuming alcoholic beverages or the offense of drunkeness in a park or cemetery shall read as follows:

- A. It shall be unlawful for any persons to bring into, possess, or consume any alcoholic or malt beverages on or in any public park or cemetery, or loiter in any intoxicated condition in such park or cemetery within or owned by the city.
- B. Upon application to the Town Council of the Town of Mills, any person may obtain permission to bring in, possess, and consume alcoholic or malt beverages on or in the areas mentioned in Subsection A. of this Section upon the terms and conditions set by the Town Council of the Town of Mills.
