AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE THE OFFENSE OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mills is in need of an Ordinance prohibiting cruelty to animals within the town limits. SECTION 1.

Cruelty to Animals. No owner shall fail to provide his animals with sufficient, good and wholesome water, proper shelter and protection from the weather, veterinary care when needed to prevent suffering, and with humane care and treatment. No person shall beat, cruelly ill-treat, torment, overload, overwork or otherwise abuse any animal or wild animal or cause or permit any dog fight, cock fight, bull fight or other combat between animals.

SECTION 2.

Repealer. Any Ordinance or Resolution of the Town of Mills in conflict herewith is hereby specifically repealed.
