## ordinance no. 306

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE AND ESTABLISH A TOWN OF MILLS EROSION CONTROL AND CONSERVATION PLAN CALLING FOR MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR CONTROLLING EROSION WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town Council of the Town of Mills that there is a need for controlling erosion within the Town of Mills, including blowing sand and debris where there is roadways or subdivisions under construction.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS THAT:

The Erosion Control and Conservation Plan attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A", shall be the minimum standards, specifications and procedures for controlling erosion for all new subdivisions or other major construction or developments within the Town of Mills. If, due to the unique characteristics of the soil or vegetation in the subdivision it is determined by the Town Council that additional requirements should be placed and adopted as part of the Erosion Control Plan then such shall be placed in the Erosion Control Conservation Plan prior approval by the owner and acceptance by the Town of Mills.

REPEALER: Any Ordinance or Resolution in conflict herewith is hereby specifically repealed.
