#### ORDINANCE NO. 348

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, RE-ENACT AND ADD TO PORTIONS OF THE ORDINANCES AND CODE PROVISIONS OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING, PERTAINING TO WATER SERVICE. THIS ORDINANCE AMENDS AND RE-ENACTS PORTIONS OF ORDINANCES NUMBERED 269, SECTION 1, 255 SECTION 1, 242 SECTIONS 2 AND 3, 160 SECTION 5, 268 SECTION 1 AND 266 SECTION 1, APPEARING IN THE MILLS MUNICIPAL CODE AS SECTION 13.04.030 PERTAINING TO WATER MAIN TAPS, INSTALLATION OF SERVICE LINES, STREET CUTS AND FEES THEREFOR; SECTION 13.04.050 PERTAINING TO CONNECTION FEES AND REQUIRED EQUIPMENT FOR WATER SERVICE; SECTION 13.04.060 PERTAINING TO WATER RATES FOR HOUSEHOLDERS; AND SECTION 13.04.090 PERTAINING TO WATER RATES FOR INDUSTRIAL USE AND EN-ACTING ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO REQUIRED INDIVIDUAL TAPS, FEES AND METERS TO BE ADDED TO THE MUNICIPAL CODE AS SECTION 13.04.070. 13.04.070.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1. That Section 13.04.030 of the Mills Munic-ipal Code, Ordinance No. 269, Section 1, 255 Section 1, 242
Section 2 and 3, 160 Section 5, 268 Section 1, and 266 Section 1, of the Town of Mills are hereby amended to read as follows:

WATER MAIN TAPS AND SERVICE LINES TO BE INSTALLED

ONLY BY TOWN PERSONNEL OR AUTHORIZED REPRESENTITIVES

STREET CUTS--FEES.

(A) Any person desiring the tapping of a water main belonging to the town for the purpose of attaching an individual line thereto, shall be required to pay the fees as specified; The fee for turning water on Section 13.04.020, the connect fee, Section 13.04.050, and the following water tap fees;

Upon payment of the fee, together with such street cut fees as are provided by ordinance or rule, the water commissioner shall, within a reasonable time thereafter, install the basic equipment for individual water service, as specified in Section 13.04.050, through the required curb box and curb cock, and including the purchase and installation of a five-eights inch by three-fourths inch water meter. It shall remain the responsibility of the owner to maintain the water meter.

(B) In the event it is necessary to install a service line of a size greater than the standard service line, the person desiring same shall be required to pay, in advance, to the town the following fees:

Upon payment of the fee, together with the street cut

fees as are provided by ordinance or rule, the water commissioner,

within a reasonable time thereafter, install the basic equipment

for individual water service as specified in Section 13.04.050;

however, the size and type of equipment shall vary with the

size of the water line, as determined by the water commissioner.

All two inch lines or larger require the installation of a

compound meter.

(C) Notwithstanding anything in this section to the contrary, the Town Council may, by written agreement, allow payment of a lower connect fee to be paid for connection and inspection in those instances where unsubdivided property is being developed or in the event of annexation to the town where the developer installs utility services at the developers sole cost and liability.

SECTION 2. That Section 13.04.050 of the Mills Munic-ipal Code, Ordinance No. 160, Section 5, of the Town of Mills is hereby amended to read as follows:

## CONNECTION FEES AND EQUIPMENT REQUIRED FOR WATER SERVICE.

Connection fees shall be based upon the cost of material and labor to connect the individual service line. The equipment for individual water service required by the town shall consist of not less than three-quarter inch brass corporation cock, to be installed at the opening that is made in the main water line, and piping, not less than three-quarter inch in diameter, for the conveyance of water from the main

line to the point at which the property to be served adjoins the street in which the main line is located. Requirements shall include a curb box and curb cock, water meter, back flow preventor, and if main line pressure exceeds 75 pounds residual pressure, a pressure regulator shall be installed prior to water meter. The meter must be installed in a location easily accessible for reading and repairing. Electrical extensions on the water meter for the convenience in reading the meter will be acceptable. A valve must be installed on each side of the water meter. The back flow preventor shall be installed on the customer side of the water meter. Valves should be within 12 inches of meter. All water lines, up to the point at which meter is installed, shall be constructed of new piping, approved by the water commissioner and installed in ground at not less than 5 feet of cover. It shall be the responsibility of property owners to protect the meter at all times from vandalism and from freezing.

SECTION 3. That Section 13.04.060 of the Mills Municipal Code, Ordinance No. 268, Section 1, of the Town of Mills is hereby amended as follows:

#### RATES FOR HOUSEHOLDERS

Unless and until otherwise established by ordinance of the council, the water fee for householders shall be ten dollars and fifty cents for each quarter year, the fee to be considered payment in full for six thousand gallons of water, or any part thereof, consumed by such householder and all water over and above the minimum quantity shall be charged for at the rate of sixty cents per thousand gallons.

SECTION 3. That Section 13.04.090 of the Mills Municipal Code, Ordinance No. 266, Section I, of the Town of Mills is hereby amended to read as follows:

### RATES FOR INDUSTRIAL CONCERNS

Unless and until otherwise established by ordinance of the council, the water fee for industrial concerns and for those generally who consume water for other than household or moderate irrigation purposes, and who employ piping and meters larger than the customary three-quarter inch for the conveyance

and measuring of water, shall be twenty-four dollars for each quarter year, which amount shall be considered as payment in full for each nine thousand gallons of water, or any part thereof, consumed in any one quarter, and all water, over and above the aforesaid quantity consumed by a concern in any one quarter, shall be paid for at the rate of seventy-eight cents per thousand gallons.

SECTION 4. That Section 10.04.070 be added to the Mills Municipal Code.

# PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO REQUIRED INDIVIDUAL TAPS, FEES AND METERS TO BE ADDED TO THE MILLS MUNICIPAL CODE

In those cases where residents are on an individual lot, each shall have an individual service tap on the main water line, with each having its own curb cock and meter. Where two or more users are on an individual tap, each shall have a meter valve and meter independent of the other.

SECTION 5. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED. Those portions of Ordinances Numbered 269, Section 1; Ordinance 255, Section 1; Ordinance Numbered 242, Sections 2 and 3; Ordinance Numbered 160, Section 5; Ordinance Numbered 268, Section 1; Ordinance Numbered 266, Section 1; appearing in the Mills Municipal Code as Sections 13.04.030, 13.04.050, 13.04.060 and 13.04.090, and any and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
