## ORDINANCE NO. 349

AN ORDINANCE TO REENACT PORTIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 276 APPEARING IN THE MILLS MUNICIPAL CODE AS SECTION 5.12.070(e) PERTAINING TO THE FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY, WYOMING, that Section 5.12.070(e) of the Mills Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

(e) The license fee to be assessed for a retail liquor license shall be One Thousand Five Hundred (\$1,500.00) Dollars, payable annually in advance.

## Section 1.

Any Ordinance or Resolution of the Town of Mills in conflict herewith is hereby specifically repealed.

## Section 2.

WHEREAS, the State Legislature has reduced the allowed fee chargeable for municipal liquor licenses; and,

WHEREAS, the present Mills Municipal Ordinance is in conflict therewith, an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance shall be deemed in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
