AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION FOUR OF ORDINANCE NO. THIRTY-FOUR, WHICH ODINANCE IS ENTITLED "AN ODINANCE CONCERNING THE WATER SYSTEM OF THE TOWN OF EILLS WYGMING, FIXING RATES THEREFOR AND RETABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO SAID WATER SYSTEM!.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COURCIL OF MEE MILLS WYGSING:

Sec. 1. That the rate to be paid by every water consumer or user shall be in the sum of one dollar and fifty cents per month, the same being hereis and hereby established as the minimum rate to be charged for the use of such water, herer where a consumer uses water for irrigation purposes, that is to irrigate a garden, laws or trees they in that case an extra charge of one dollar and fifty cents shall be made and collected from such consumer who uses water for such irrigation purposes, for each lot or part where of lot so irrigated from the second day of July to the first day of October, 1924; provided however that this section shall not apply to consumers using maders.

Sec. 2, That all consumers installing water after the passage of this ordinance shall place attacks their own expense a standard meter for the purpose of measuring such mater used, and each consumer having meter shall be allowed a maxisim of 1500 gallons per forth at the rate of one dollar and fifty cents per month, and all consumers using more than 1500 gallons per month shall pay \$.20 per thousand gallons for all water used in excess of the maxisum.

Sec. 3. That all consumers using water at this time who have not installed meters for the purpose of measuring such water shall install at their own expence standard meters, that meet the council's requirements. for the purpose of measuring such water, which meters shall be installed befor the first day of October of 1924.

Sec. 4. That this ordinance shall be an amendment to Section Four of Crainsnee Sumber Thirty-four, which ordinance is antitled " AN CRIMANCE CONCERNING THE WARRE SYSTEM OF THE TOWN OF MILLS WYOMING, PIXING RATES THEREFOR AND RETARLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO SAID WATER SU SUPPLY."

ORDINANCE # 34 A

Sec. 5, Any person, firm or corporation richating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemear or and shall be fined not more than One Hundred Dollars or be imprisoned in the Town jail of the Town of Mills not more than ninety days, or both fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 6, Whereas an emergency exists, such is hereby declared to be the case, therefor this ordinance shally take effect and be in force from and after its passage, without previous publication or posting.
