

ORDINANCE NO. 36A

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO FARGO OIL CO., A WYOMING CORPORATION, OF CASPER, WYOMING, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, A FRANCHISE TO BUILD, LAY, CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE A SIX INCH IRON OIL CARRYING PIPE LINE UPON, IN AND UNDER PENDELL BOULEVARD AND RAILWAY AVENUE, AND A TELEPHONE LINE FROM THE WEST END OF PENDELL BOULEVARD TO A POINT OPPOSITE THE ALLEY BETWEEN BENTON AVENUE AND RIVER VIEW AVENUE IN THE TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY, WYO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY, STATE OF WYOMING:-

Sec. 1, There is hereby granted to the Fargo Oil Co., a Wyo. corporation, of Casper, Wyo., its successors and assigns, a full and complete right, authority, privilege and franchise, to lay, build, construct, operate and maintain a six (6) inch extra heavy iron oil carrying pipeline and fittings over, upon, in and under Pendell Boulevard and Northwestern Avenue, and a telephone from the west end of Pendell Boulevard to a point opposite the alley between Benton and Riverview Avenue, in the Town of Mills, Natrona County, Wyoming.

Sec. 2, Said oil carrying pipeline shall be laid along the north end of Pendell Boulevard not more than two (2) feet from the north side of said Pendell Boulevard, and shall be laid along Northwestern Avenue from the property line to within eight (8) feet of the water main on the easterly side of the said Northwestern Avenue; said line shall be laid so as not to injure or interfere with the water lines and service lines of the Town of Mills, aforesaid and so as not to injure or interfere with other water, gas oil or gas line lines laid in said Pendell Boulevard and Northwestern Avenue; said telephone line shall be built and constructed between the property line and pipeline on the north line of Pendell Boulevard in the Town of Mills aforesaid.

Sec. 3, All the rights and privileges granted to the Fargo Oil Co. under this franchise or its successors and assigns, shall be in full force and effect for a term of ninety-nine (99) years from and after this ordinance becomes effective.

Sec. 4, The Mayor and Clerk of the Town of Mills are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Fargo Oil Co. embodying the terms of this franchise.

Page 2, Ordinance # 36A.

Sec. 5, Whereas an emergency exists, such is declared to be the case, and there fore this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage.
