ORDINANCE NO. THIRTY-RIGHT

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO E. E. EVANS, OF MILLS, WYOMING. THE RIGHT TO BUILD, ERECT, MAINTAIN AND CONDUCT AN AMUSEMENT PARK WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF MILLS. WYOMING, AND PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION THEREOF AND THE PAYMENT OF A LICENSE FEE THERE FORE.

Be it Ordained by the Town council of the Town of Mills, Wyoming.

Sec. 1. That there is hereby granted to E. E. Evans of the Town of Mills, Wyoming, the right to build, erect, maintain and opperate upon pieces and park parcels of land owned or controlled by the said E. E. Evans, an amusement parks containing concessions of verious kinds and among others a plung or swimming pool, a dance pavillion, a Verris wheel, a merry-go-round, and such other amusement concessions as may be desired by the said grantee, for and during and untill the first day of May, 1925, unless the grant herein made shall be sooner revolked for proper cause by the Mayor and Town Council.

Sec. 2, That the said . E. Evans grantee, shall pay unto the Town Clerk for the use and bennirit of the Town of Mills as a resonable fee for the grant herein made, the summ of \$25.00 per month for each and every month of the opperation of said amusement park, said license fee to be paid upon kt the first day of each and every calender month.

Sec. 3, That said E. E. Evans, grantee, shall be held strictly accoutable for the enforcement of order within the confines of said amusement park at his own ex pense, provided, however, that the council may, at its discretion, deputize or appoint one or more officers to preserve order in the said amusement park who shall be chothed with all the authority to make arests and preserve order that other peace officers of the Town of Mills may have.

Sec. 4, That the said grantee stall, as soon as may be possible and with in a reasonable time, construct a bypass water pipe line from the municipial pumping station of the Town of Hills, to the plunge or swimming pool in said proposed amusement park, which said by-pass pipe shall be constructed for the primary purpose of fire prevention, with the privelege, however, given the grantee herein to convey water through the said by-pass pipe to the plunge in said amusement park at his convenience and as he may desire, and provided further that the water passing through said by-pass pipe shall be metered at or near the municipal pumping station, and that the grantee herein, shall shall pay to the Town of Mills the rate of ten cents per thousand gallons of water passing through said by-pass pipe for his use, and provided further, that emediatly upon the completion of the constuction of said by-pass pipe.

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without the same shall pass to and vest in the said Yown of Mills absolutly, and provided further that as a scans of preventing fires the said by-pass line shall be opened immediatly by grantee in any fire hazard and allowed to remain open as long as any danger exists, and provided further, that untill completion of said by pass line by grantee as herein provided he shall pay unto the Town of Mills for water consumed at the rate of twenty cents per thousand gallons and provided further that the vight of this grantee to appropriate water t through the said by-pass line shall be at all times subject to and subordinates to the use of said water by the Emploipality.

Sec/ 5. That the said 2. I. Evans, grantee, shall conduct the said amusement park in a project, orderly and lawfull manner,: shall make resonable and project, orderly and lawfull manner,: shall make resonable and project proper recantions to prevent accidents or injurity to persons or projectly, and shall not commit or allow to be permitted, any nuisease in said sause ment park; that he the said grantee, shall provide for the exclusion of the general public Myom said park by the charging of a reasonable admittion fee and the feacing of the park in an effective manner: that all of the said park, together with the amusements devices therin centained, shall be constructed upon property gwined by the grantee of controled by him, and that no obstruction of any kind or nature shall or hay be placed by grantee in any of the streets of said town of kills of in any place in said for rown where the same may ar shall become a nuiseach.

Sec. 6. That nothing in this ordinance apathined shallbe construed as granting unto said E. E. Evans any right to construct or maintain any device in the nuture of a nuisance or which pay he inherently dangerous in its opporations, or which shall relieve the grantee of sole and absolute resposability from any and all sots committed by him or his agents.

Sec. 7. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the council and the publication in the official papers Passed their 7th day of May . 1924.
