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E. E. EVANS AMUSEMENT PARK FRANCHISE

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ORDINANCE NO. THIRTY-EIGHT

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO E. E. EVANS, OF MILLS, WYOMING, THE RIGHT TO BUILD, ERECT, MAINTAIN AND CONDUCT AN AMUSEMENT PARK WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING, AND PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION THEREOF AND THE PAYMENT OF A LICENSE FEE THEREFORE.

Be it Ordained by the Town council of the Town of Mills, Wyoming.

Sec. 1, That there is hereby granted to E. E. Evans of the Town of Mills, Wyoming, the right to build, erect, maintain and operate upon pieces and ~~par~~ parcels of land owned or controlled by the said E. E. Evans, an amusement park containing concessions of various kinds and among others a plunge or swimming pool, a dance pavillion, a Ferris wheel, a merry-go-round, and such other amusement concessions as may be desired by the said grantee, for and during and untill the first day of May, 1925, unless the grant herein made shall be sooner revoked for proper cause by the Mayor and Town Council.

Sec. 2, That the said E. E. Evans, grantee, shall pay unto the Town Clerk for the use and benefit of the Town of Mills as a reasonable fee for the grant herein made, the sum of \$25.00 per month for each and every month of the operation of said amusement park, said license fee to be paid upon ~~at~~ the first day of each and every calender month.

Sec. 3, That said E. E. Evans, grantee, shall be held strictly accountable for the enforcement of order within the confines of said amusement park at his own expense, provided, however, that the council may, at its discretion, deputize or appoint one or more officers to preserve order in the said amusement park who shall be clothed with all the authority to make arrests and preserve order that other peace officers of the Town of Mills may have.

Sec. 4, That the said grantee shall, as soon as may be possible and within a reasonable time, construct a bypass water pipe line from the municipal pumping station of the Town of Mills, to the plunge or swimming pool in said proposed amusement park, which said by-pass pipe shall be constructed for the primary purpose of fire prevention, with the privilege, however, given the grantee herein to convey water through the said by-pass pipe to the plunge in said amusement park at his convenience and as he may desire, and provided further that the water passing through said by-pass pipe shall be metered at or near the municipal pumping station, and that the grantee herein, ~~shall~~ shall pay to the Town of Mills the rate of ten cents per thousand gallons of water passing through said by-pass pipe for his use, and provided further, that immediately upon the completion of the construction of said by-pass pipe,

Title to the same shall pass to and vest in the said Town of Mills absolutely, and provided further that as a means of preventing fires the said by-pass line shall be opened immediatly by grantee in any fire hazard and allowed to remain open as long as any danger exists, and provided further, that untill completion of said by pass line by grantee as herein provided he shall pay unto the Town of Mills for water consumed at the rate of twenty cents per thousand gallons and provided further that the right of this grantee to appropriate water through the said by-pass line shall be at all times subject to and subordinate to the use of said water by the municipality.

Sec/ 5, That the said E. S. Evans, grantee, shall conduct the said amusement park in a proper, orderly and lawfull manner,; shall make reasonable and proper regulations for the safty of the persons patronizing the same; shall take all reasonable and proper precautions to prevent accidents or injury to persons or property, and shall not commit or allow to be permitted, any nuisance in said amuse ment park; that he the said grantee, shall provide for the exclusion of the general public from said park by the charging of a reasonable admition fee and the fencing of the park in an effective manner; that all of the said park, together with the amusements devices therein contained, shall be constructed upon property owned by the grantee or controled by him, and that no obstruction of any kind or nature shall or may be placed by grantee in any of the streets of said town of Mills or in any place in said xx Town where the same may or shall become a nuisance.

Sec. 6, That nothing in this ordinance contained shall be construed as granting unto said E. S. Evans any right to construct or maintain any device in the nature of a nuisance or which may be inherently dangerous in its operations, or which shall relieve the grantee of sole and absolutr responsibility from any and all acts committed by him or his agents.

Sec. 7, That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the council and the publication in the official papers
