ORDINANCE NO. 394

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING INNES ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY, WYOMING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mills is desirous of annexing the lands hereinafter described and including said lands within the corporate limits of the Town of mills, and;

whereas, it is determined by the Town Council of the Town of Mills that an annexation of the area hereinafter described is for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the persons residing in the area and in the Town of Mills, and;

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the development of the area sought to be annexed would constitute a natural geographical, economical and social part of the Town of Mills, and;

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town
Council that the area sought to be annexed is a logical and
feasible addition to the Town of Mills and that the
extension of basic services such as water and sewer
services, police and fire protection and other services
customarily available to the residents of the Town of Mills,
can reasonably be furnished, if not now within the near
future, to the area proposed to be annexed, and;

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town
Council that the area sought to be annexed is contiguous
with, and adjacent to the boundaries of the Town of Mills,
and;

WHEREAS, it has been determined the the petitioner for annexation is the owner of all the land sought to be annexed, and;

WHEREAS, it will be necessary for the owner of the property and the Town of Mills to enter into an annexation agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Mills, Wyoming;

Section 1:

That a certain tract of land being a part of the SW1/4NE1/4 of Section 11, Township 33 North, Range 80 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Natrona County, Wyoming, being more particularly described on Exhibit "A", the Final Plat, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, be and the same is annexed to and included within the boundaries of the Town of Mills, Natrona County, Wyoming.

Section 2:

That areas herein annexed and hereinbefore described shall be known as Innes Addition to the Town of Mills, Natrona County, Wyoming.

Section 3:

That a plat showing the boundaries of said annexed tract has been submitted to and is approved by the Town of Mills. The Mayor and Town Clerk are authorized to sign, attest and affix the seal of the Town on said plat and said plat shall be filed for record in the office of the County Clerk, and ex-officio Register of Deeds in Natrona County, Wyoming.

Section 4:

Petitioner presently receives water from Brooks Water and Sewer District and shall continue to look to the District for water.

Section 5:

Upon approval of this ordinance and effective date of annexation, Innes Addition shall be zoned Developing Business, D-B, under Mills Zoning, Ordinance 312.



Section 7:

That the annexation of said tract of land to the Town of Mills shall become effective upon the passage of this Ordinance and after the signing of the written Annexation Agreement between petitioner and the Town.
