

ORDINANCE NO. 395

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF FISCHER AVENUE,
A DEDICATED ROADWAY WITHIN THE TOWN OF MILLS,
NATRONA COUNTY, WYOMING, TO EXCAL WAY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS,
WYOMING.

WHEREAS, EXCAL Foundry has purchased the sole building located along Fischer Avenue and all property which abuts Fischer Avenue and will establish their business there, and;

WHEREAS, EXCAL will be the only property owner along said roadway and will be the only business located along said roadway, and;

WHEREAS, EXCAL is desirous of having an identifiable street address, and;

WHEREAS, after notification of all the land owners adjacent to Fischer Avenue, and after a public hearing at which there was no opposition to changing the name of the roadway, the Council determined the name change was in order,

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Mills, Wyoming:


That the name of Fischer Avenue shall hereby be changed to EXCAL Way, and that the County Clerk be notified, the Town map be corrected, and that all street signs be corrected to reflect the change.

PASSED on SECOND READING the 6 day of Feb, 1991.


PASSED on THIRD READING the 3 day of Apr, 1991.
