

ORDINANCE NO. 40

An ordinance amending and reenacting into certain parts thereof Ordinance No. 11 of the Town of Mills, Wyoming, relating to the licensing and regulation of dogs, chickens, cattle and other domestic animals.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SEC. 1. That Section of Ordinance no. 11 of said Town of Mills be amended and reenacted to read as follows, to wit: "Every owner or possessor, and every person who harbors or keeps any dog or dogs within the corporate limits of the Town of Mills shall annually pay to the Town Clerk of the Town of Mills for the use and benefit of the Town, the sum of \$3.00 for each and every male dog, and the sum of \$5.00 for each and every female dog owned, possessed, harbored or kept by such person."

SEC. 11. That Section 4 of said ordinance be amended and reenacted to read as follows, to-wit: "The Town Marshall shall have the right to impound any such domestic animal for a period of five days or longer if, in his judgment, the keeping for an additional period would be justified, and to retain said animal in the municipal pound until redeemed by the person owning, or entitled to possession, of the same, by the payment of a sum of fifty cents (.50) per day and all expenses incurred in the keeping of said animal and a license for said keeping shall have been purchased. In the event that such animal shall not be redeemed within said five-day period, the Town Marshall, Ex-officio Pound Master, is hereby given authority to destroy said animal."

SEC. 111. That it is declared to be the intention of the Town Council that the remainder of said Ordinance No. 11 shall stand unrevoked and unrevoked.

SEC. 1V. This ordinance shall take effect and be binding from and after ten days after its passage, approval and publication.
