

ORDINANCE NO. 407

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND
RE-ENACT §7 OF ORDINANCE 59 PROHIBITING
LOUD AND UNNECESSARY NOISES AND PROVID-
ING A PENALTY THEREFOR

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS,
WYOMING:

Section 1. Section 7 of Ordinance 59 is herewith repealed
and re-enacted as follows:

It is unlawful for any person to make, continue to cause
to be made, or continue any loud, unnecessary, or unusual noise
or noises by yelling, singing, whistling, shouting, or otherwise
emitted from any source whether electronically amplified or not
which annoys, disturbs, injures, or endangers the comfort,
repose, health, peace, or safety of any person within the Town
of Mills. It is unlawful for any person to use, operate, or
permit to be used, operated, or played any radio, television,
musical instrument, tape recorder, phonograph, or other elec-
tronic machine whether amplified or not, or other device for
the production or reproduction of sound in any manner that
disturbs the peace, quiet, and comfort of any person in the
Town at any time with a volume louder than is necessary for
convenient hearing by the person or persons who are in the
room, vehicle, or chamber in which such machine or device is
operated and who are voluntarily listeners thereto.

Section 2. Violation - Penalty. Any person violating any
provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor
and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine or fines not
exceeding Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) for each
violation to which may be added court costs.

Section 3. Declaration of Emergency - Effective Date.
Since the immediate operation of the provisions of this Ordi-
nance is necessary for the preservation of public peace,
health, and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Town Council.
