

ORDINANCE NO. 411

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PAY FOR THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF MILLS AND THE PAY FOR EACH COUNCIL PERSON OF THE TOWN OF MILLS; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND AMENDING OR REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Mills, Wyoming:

SECTION 1. SALARY FOR MAYOR.

The salary to be paid to the Mayor of the Town of Mills shall be Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) per month.

SECTION 2. SALARY FOR COUNCIL.

The salary for each Council person shall be Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for actual attendance at each regular or special meeting of the Council.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days following its passage and approval on third and final reading; however, the provisions of this Ordinance shall not be given retroactive effect with regard to any present Council person or Mayor duly elected and serving at the time of the passage of this Ordinance but shall only affect compensation or salary to be paid to the office of Mayor and Council persons after the next election for each such office.

SECTION 4. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

All existing Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of the Town of Mills are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY OF PROVISIONS.


It is the intention of the Council that each separate provision of this Ordinance be deemed independent of all other provisions, and it is further the intention of the Council that if any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid for any reason that all other provisions hereof shall remain valid and enforceable.



AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX LEVY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING FEBRUARY 28, 1994.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING.


