

ORDINANCE NO. 419

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ASSAULT AND BATTERY;  
DEFINING ASSAULT; DEFINING BATTERY;  
ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION; AND  
ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS,  
WYOMING:

Section 1. "Assault" Defined. An assault occurs when a person unlawfully attempts to cause bodily injury to another or threatens to inflict bodily injury to another when coupled with an apparent present ability to do so.

Section 2. "Battery" Defined. A battery occurs if a person unlawfully touches another in a rude, insolent or angry manner or intentionally, knowingly or recklessly causes bodily injury to another.

Section 3. Assault or Battery Prohibited. No person shall commit an assault or battery in the Town of Mills.

Section 4. Penalty for Violation. Any person committing an assault or battery in violation of this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor and may be fined in any sum deemed appropriate by the Municipal Court of the Town of Mills not to exceed \$750.00 for each violation.

Section 5. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. Any existing ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of Mills are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 6. Separability of Provisions. Each separate provision of this ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions and if any provision of this ordinance be declared invalid for any reason, all other provisions hereof shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section 7. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days following its passage and approval on final reading.

PASSED, APPROVED and ADOPTED on THIRD and FINAL READING the 4th day of May, 1994.
