

ORDINANCE NO. 449

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTERS 2.08 AND 2.36
OF THE TOWN OF MILLS MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO MUNICIPAL
RECREATION CENTERS, PARKS BOARD AND LIBRARY BOARD

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN
OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1:

Sections 2.08.010 through 2.08.150 both inclusive, Title 2, Chapter 8 of the Ordinances of the
Town of Mills, Wyoming, pertaining to Municipal Recreation Centers and Parks Board are hereby
repealed.

SECTION 2

Sections 2.36.010 through 2.36.090 both inclusive, Title 2, Chapter 36 of the Ordinances of the
Town of Mills, Wyoming, pertaining to the Town of Mills Library Board are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage on three readings and
publication.
