Passed and approved this 19 day of June, A.D. 1934

and a copy of said notice shall be served upon the owner or person entitled to the possession of such animal, at least (5) days prior to such sale. If such owner be known to the said Town Marshall, or can be ascertained by said Town Marshall, upon due and diligent search or inquiry made therefor but any such animal may be redeemed at any time before the public sale by payment of the said expenses, penalty and costs aforesaid.

Section 4. In case any animal sold, pursuant to the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be sold for more than sufficient to discharge the expense and penalty and costs aforesaid, such excess shall be, and by the officer making the sale, deposit with the Town Treasurer, which shall be paid upon an order of the Town Council, to the owner or person entitled to the possession of the same, upon claim and proper proof before said Town Council Section 5. Any person who shall hinder or obstruct or delay the Town Marshall or his ^{any} assistant in taking such animal into custody shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than two (2) dollars nor more than fifty (50) dollars for each offence.

Section 6. Shall any person break open, or in any manner directly or indirectly aid or assist in breaking open any pen or enclosure, with the intent of releasing any animal confined there in pursuant to the provisions of this Ordinance, every person upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than one Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

Section 7. All Ordinances or Parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 8. Whereas an emergency exists, such is hereby declared to be the case, and, therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
