

ORDINANCE NO. 467

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15.08.100 OF THE
MILLS MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO ELECTRICAL CODES
FOR THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the Town of Mills, Wyoming has previously appointed the State of Wyoming Electrical Inspector to perform electrical inspections pursuant to its building and electrical codes.

WHEREAS the Town of Mills, Wyoming has recently appointed the Natrona County Electrical Inspector to perform its inspections in an effort to provide inspections for residents of the Town in a more timely and efficient manner.

WHEREAS in order that the County Electrical Inspector be available to perform such inspections, the Town's existing fee schedule for electrical inspections should be revised to conform with the schedule of fees applicable to other residents of Natrona County, Wyoming.

WHEREAS the public health, safety, and welfare will be served by the immediate amendment of the schedule of fees for electrical inspections in order than electrical inspection services be immediately available to residents of the Town of Mills, Wyoming.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING, THAT CHAPTER 15.08.100 OF THE MILLS MUNICIPAL CODE BE AND HEREBY IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

15.08.100 Fees. (a) Written Application and Schedule of Fees. Before any company, firm, co-partnership, corporation or individual shall do any electrical wiring, either new work or an addition to old work, a written application must be filed with the town electrical inspector for a permit. **The Town Council shall adopt by resolution a schedule of Permit Fees in accordance with the Chapter.** The fee for a permit shall be paid in accordance with the currently adopted Permit Fee schedule at the time the permit is issued.

SERVICES

~~For new service, change of service, alteration or repair of six hundred volt capacity or less, entrance equipment fees shall be computed in accordance with the following table, using wire capacity to determine rating:~~

~~For each 100 amp capacity or fraction thereof over 100 amp in excess of minimum \$ 1.00~~

~~Each additional meter on the same service \$ 1.00~~

~~Electrical inspection fees for all wiring in hazardous location shall be at double the appropriate rate for standard wiring.~~

~~In order to insure prompt inspection, the full name and address of the owner and/or agent must be given at the time permit is secured.~~

Whenever possible, all permits must be secured and inspections called for before one thirty p.m. on week days, and whenever practical and possible, inspections will be completed on the same day they are called. (Ord. 161 §6, 1966).

SECTION 2:

Pursuant to W.S. §15-1-115(c) for an emergency Ordinance, the requirements relating to public readings and the ten (10) day elapse between introduction and passage may be suspended by the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the qualified members of the governing body; and, pursuant to W.S. §15-1-115(d), the passage of an emergency Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the qualified members of the governing body.

SECTION 3:

Pursuant to W.S. §15-1-105(a)(iii), an emergency Ordinance means an Ordinance operating for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare, in which the emergency is defined.


SECTION 4:


