

## ORDINANCE NO. 474

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 469 PERTAINING TO THE BUDGET OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING Ordinance No. 469 pertaining to the budget of the Town of Mills, Wyoming contained errors or omission with respect to the budget of the Mills Police Department and WHEREAS the budget should immediately be amended to provide additional funds for Mills Police Department to serve the public health, safety and welfare.

WHEREAS the Town of Mills, Wyoming is desirous of increasing speed enforcement efforts by its police department and WHEREAS grant moneys are available for such purpose from the Wyoming Department of Transportation and WHEREAS the immediate appropriation of such funds is necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare.

WHEREAS the Town of Mills, Wyoming has undertaken a project to construct affordable housing within the Town of Mills, Wyoming, and WHEREAS the costs as previously budgeted by the Town of Mills, Wyoming, are insufficient to complete said project, and WHEREAS the completion of said project will serve the public health, safety and welfare.

WHEREAS the Town of Mills, Wyoming has undertaken a project to construct pedestrian walkways from WOTCO to Thirteenth Street and from WOTCO to Wyoming Boulevard within the Town of Mills, Wyoming, and WHEREAS the construction costs as previously budgeted by the Town of Mills, Wyoming, are insufficient to complete said project, and WHEREAS the completion of said project will serve the public health and welfare.

WHEREAS the geography and climate of the Town of Mills, Wyoming provides a limited construction season for the completion of said projects, and WHEREAS the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the residents would be served by the immediate appropriation of funds necessary for said projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

#### SECTION 1:

Ordinance No. 469 pertaining to the Budget of the Town of Mills, Wyoming is hereby amended to provide additional funding for the Town of Mills, Wyoming Police Department in the amount of \$29,593.00 to correct errors or omissions in the budget.

#### SECTION 2:

Ordinance No. 469 pertaining to the Budget of the Town of Mills, Wyoming is hereby amended to provide additional funding to the Town of Mills Police Department in the amount of \$12,000.00 for purposes of increased speed enforcement.

#### SECTION 3:

Ordinance No. 469 pertaining to the Budget of the Town of Mills, Wyoming is hereby amended to provide additional funding into the Town of Mills, Wyoming General Fund in the amount of \$8,020.00 for the purposes of construction affordable housing within the Town of Mills, Wyoming.

#### SECTION 4:

Ordinance No. 469 pertaining to the Budget of the Town of Mills, Wyoming is hereby amended to provide additional funding into the Town of Mills, Wyoming General Fund in the amount of

\$36,792.00 for the construction of pedestrian walkways from WOTCO to Thirteenth Street and from WOTCO to Wyoming Boulevard within the Town of Mills, Wyoming.

SECTION 5:

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING that the funding source for the budget increases authorized herein shall include grants from the Wyoming Department of Transportation in amounts estimated at \$12,000.00 for speed enforcement and \$45,340.00 for street maintenance, and any further funding shall be any unencumbered surplus funds from the Town of Mills Reserve Fund Account.

SECTION 6:

Pursuant to W.S. §15-1-115(c) for an emergency Ordinance, the requirements relating to public readings and the ten (10) day elapse between introduction and passage may be suspended by the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the qualified members of the governing body; and, pursuant to W.S. §15-1-115(d), the passage of an emergency Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the qualified members of the governing body.

SECTION 7:

Pursuant to W.S. §15-1-105(a)(iii), an emergency Ordinance means an Ordinance operating for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare, in which the emergency is defined.

SECTION 8:

For the reasons set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance, the Council finds and declares that an emergency exists; that this Ordinance is for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and that it shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its approval.

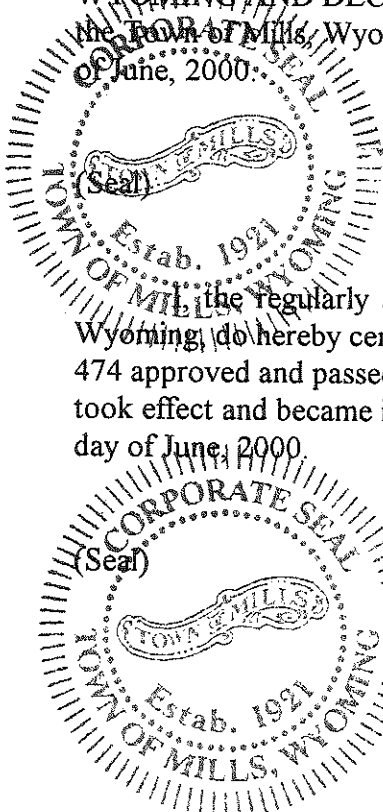
